Important Notes:

- Call the Fire Chief at 360.853.8401 or Skagit County Fire Marshall at 360.416.1845 to schedule an inspection at least two business days prior to tank removal. The Fire Chief or Fire Marshall must witness removal of the tank.
- Abandonment or removal of an underground fuel tank in place can only be done by a licensed contractor with International Fire Code Institution (IFCI) certification as a tank decommissioner.
- Notice to, and permits from, the Department of Ecology may be required for any underground storage tank OTHER than heating oil and farm or residential motor field tanks less than 1100 gallons. See www.ecy.wa.gov/programs/tcp/ust-lust/tanks.html
