NEW PROGRAM TO HELP IMPROVE TOWN'S PARKS

The Parks Committee of the Town of Concrete has created a way for community volunteers to help make the town's parks more attractive and useful. The new "Adopt a Spot" program encourages community organizations, school clubs, businesses, and families to take an active role in improving the Town of Concrete parks, spots and public spaces.

By adopting a spot in town, volunteers will be increasing the number of public places where the natural beauty shines through. Clean, well-kept spaces provide a positive impression to visitors, enhance public pride in our town and can add to the play spaces for children and pets.

Adopting a spot not only promotes physical activity and better health for those who maintain the space, but also encourages others to get active.

Other benefits might include a reduction in vandalism and graffiti throughout town, and also provide an opportunity for volunteers to meet new people and be recognized as someone who cares about the community.

Adopt-a-Spot groups will do some or all of the following in their adopted space:

- Pick up litter, pull weeds
- Rake leaves, sweep paved areas
- Report and/or help remove graffiti
- Report hazards
- Keep shrubs and gardens maintained
- Woodchip trees and shrub beds
- Offer suggestions for improvement in public spaces
- Encourage others to keep our public spaces clean and litter-free

Adopt-A-Spot groups will be provided with training from Parks Committee volunteers and expected to participate in two community-wide clean-up activities throughout the year.

ADOPT-A-SPOT AGREEMENT

This agreement is entered into between the Town of Concrete and the volunteer organization _____

Spot being adopted: _____

The volunteer organization agrees to:

1. Assign a leader or contact person for their organization. The contact person will keep a copy of this agreement. The crew leader or contact person will supply the Parks Committee with a roster of participants so the Committee may recognize their efforts.
2. Insure that volunteer participants are adults age 18 years of age or older, or that there is one adult supervisor for every 6 minors under age 18.
3. Complete clean-up tasks at a minimum of once each month, with litter pick-up happening more frequently or as needed. One spring clean-up day is required (TBD).
4. Include in clean-up: litter collection, raking, cleaning planter areas, sweeping pathways and other designated tasks as agreed upon between the Parks Committee and volunteer organization.
5. Use or obtain their own tools, supplies and materials or in some instances arrange for loan of tools and supplies from the Parks Committee.
6. Conduct park maintenance and cleanup activities in a safe manner. Do not pick up syringes, hypodermic needles, or exceptionally large, heavy items. These items should be reported to the Parks Committee as soon as possible for proper disposal.
