## MOBILE CHIPPING APPLICATION

This service is to provide an alternative to burning to those residents living within the town limits of Town of Concrete or within the Urban Growth Area of Town of Concrete. This service is for residential properties only and is not intended for commercial or land-clearing use. The Town of Concrete will offer mobile chipping services on the second and fourth Thursdays of each month as weather and, workload allows. Your debris pile must be placed at the beginning of the main entrance to your property so that it is readily accessible for the PW Department.

Please see back of this form for additional rules and information on how limbs and branches should be stacked.

The cost for this service shall be:

- \$25.00—For in Town Limits—per resident, per appointment.
- \$32.50—For in UGA—per resident, per appointment.
- Additional Fees may apply to pile sizes exceeding 4X4X8

All fees must be paid prior to your appointment date.

Tell us if you wish to keep the chips or if you want them to be hauled away. If you wish to keep the chips, they will be placed as near as possible to the debris pile being chipped.

**Items to be chipped must be limbs  
or branches ONLY!**

All wood and yard debris that include blackberries, treated or untreated lumber, processed wood, dirt, rocks, stumps, grass, leaves, briars, shrubs with thorns, nails, screws, landscaping material, metal, concrete, noxious weeds, bamboo, or ivy will not be chipped. It will be the duty of the resident to ensure that none of the items stated for non-chipping are included in the pile or the pile will be left and become the responsibility of the resident to haul and/or remove.

Limbs and Branches should be stacked neatly, facing the road/access point and within 6ft of the road/access point but not in the road. Jumbled and disorganized piles are difficult and time consuming and may be left to the responsibility of the owner.
